Beginning on Monday, November 27th, KBX (Georgia Pacific) will begin requiring tracking on all shipments from Sweetwater. We have decided the best way to do this without violating your rights and lease agreement is to use the KBX Logistics APP. You will have the instructions included with your paystubs. Please check your email.

We will begin utilizing drop trailers again with GP in the near future and will update you when that is set up.

A few reminders as we come into the winter:

Freight is slowing down. I know we have had box loads lately but once the severe weather comes in, those jobsites will slow down or stop. Other freight will also slow as the winter comes in. Tarping may become more common as well so please make sure you have a reliable weather app. We are doing all we can to keep you all rolling but, we can not force customers to ship loads or give us everything they have. This is why we recommend saving when the loads are moving.

Detention pay is only approved by the customer. You must notify Dillon first and write down our arrival and departure time on your paperwork. Detention is NEVER guaranteed.

Check in is required DAILY by 10am. **DO NOT TEXT OR CALL DILLON BEFORE 8AM OR AFTER 5 PM UNLESS IT IS AN EMERGENCY.** Check in close to 10am with your status.
